

License Exception - Baggage (BAG) Certification

License exception BAG ([15 CFR §740.14](#)) under the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) authorizes University of Arizona U.S. Persons leaving the U.S. to export or reexport certain **personally owned** commodities (e.g., laptops, tablets, digital storage devices), software, or technology as a “tool of trade” to any destination or series of destinations provided it is not to Iran, North Korea, Sudan, or Syria. “Tools of trade” are those items such as tools, instruments, equipment, or technology for use in the individual’s occupation/employment.

Software and technology used as a tool of trade may be used overseas solely by the individual listed above provided adequate security precautions are taken to protect against unauthorized access. Examples of adequate security precautions include: encryption of technology; the use of Virtual Private Network (VPN) connections when accessing email and other business activities; use of passwords on all electronic devices; and, the use of personal firewalls.

Individuals leaving the U.S. temporarily (*i.e.*, traveling) **must** bring back all items export and reexported under this License Exception. All items must remain in the individual’s “effective control” (defined as retaining physical possession of the item or keeping it secured in a place such as a hotel safe, a bonded warehouse, or a locked or guarded exhibition facility) while abroad.

This exception does not apply to anything controlled under the Department of State’s International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR).
