What is SciENcv?



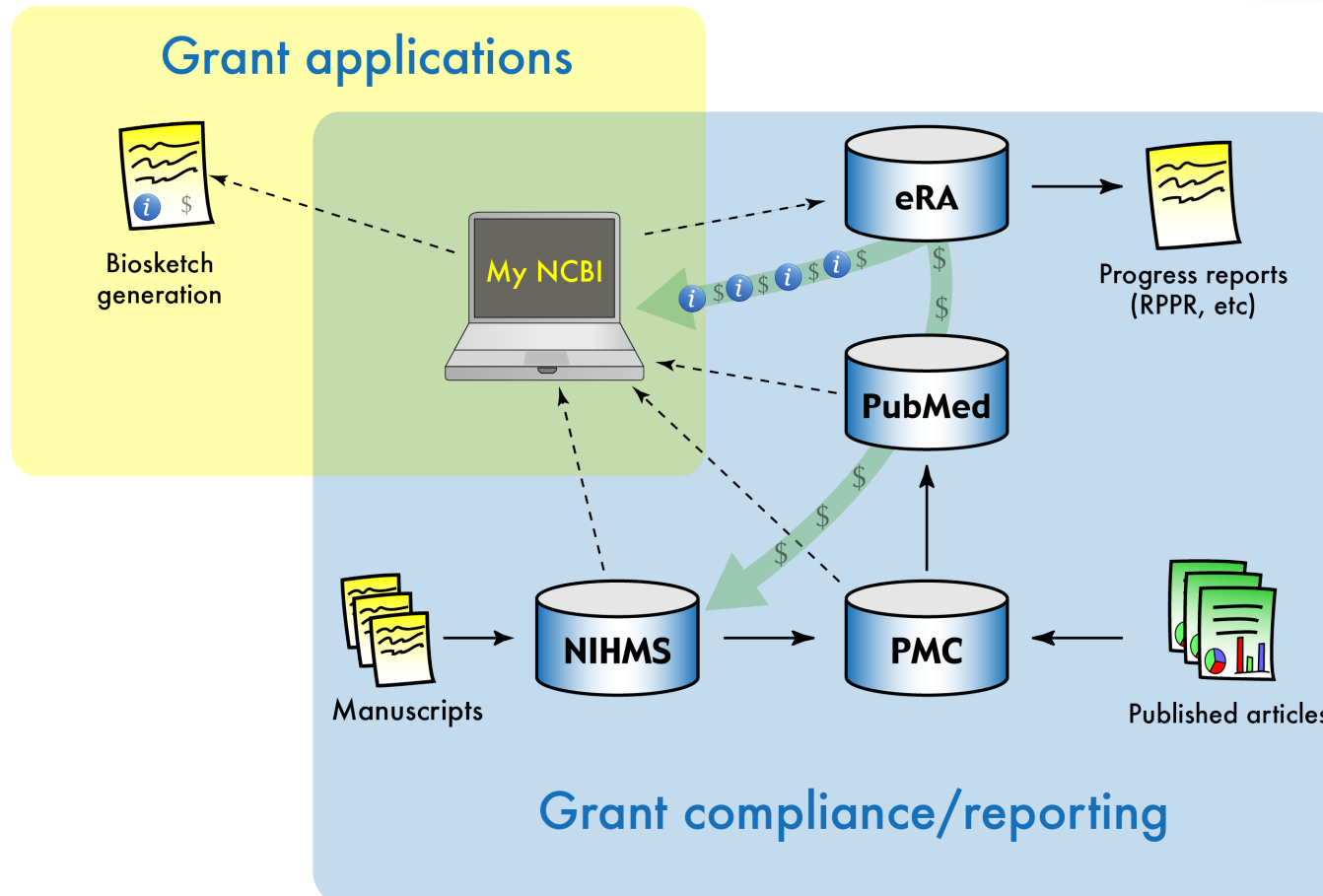
- Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae
- Developed by the National Center for Biotechnology Information (NCBI)
- Electronic system that helps researchers to streamline the preparation and management of their biosketches
- Available in MyNCBI

Why SciENcv?



- Provides standardized biosketch template in approved format
 - NIH, NSF, IES, and NIH Fellowship
- Stores completed/ongoing biosketches online in a single place
 - Easy to find
 - Can re-use
- Allows researcher and delegate to work on a single biosketch
- Capability of pulling data from other profiles/accounts to pre-populate the biosketch
 - eRA Commons (NIH), ORCID, Research.gov (NSF)


Delegate Access
